Seabreeze High School believes all students are responsible for helping to maintain a safe and orderly environment. The rules and procedures listed below are to assist the students of Seabreeze High School in preparing to follow the rules and procedures they will have to follow in the real world.

1. Students are to park in their assigned areas: Hang tags are required to hang from your rear view mirror of your vehicle at all times. Students must have a “B” average, no excessive referrals or financial obligations to be eligible to park on campus.
2. Students are not allowed to sit in their cars or loiter in parking lots at any time.
3. DO NOT use cars as lockers or return to your car during the school day.
4. The administration of Seabreeze High School may have to make adjustments concerning student parking, if the need arises.
5. The following actions will result in the possible loss of your parking privilege. You will have to re-register and pay the parking fee if your parking privilege is restored.
 - ❖ Returning late to campus after lunch
 - ❖ Reckless driving and/or speeding. Maximum speed is 5 mph.
 - ❖ Leaving campus without following school checkout procedures.
 - ❖ Vandalism to school or personal property-reimbursement costs
 - ❖ Playing car radio too loudly on campus
 - ❖ Failure to park within marked parking areas/blocking gates or traffic lanes
 - ❖ Transporting students of any grade who do not have off campus privileges
 - ❖ Failure to serve detentions
 - ❖ Parking on the grass, non-lined pavement or in the faculty or visitor parking
 - ❖ Removing a hang tag and placing it on an unregistered vehicle
 - ❖ Parking an unregistered vehicle on campus
 - ❖ Failure to maintain 2.5 GPA
 - ❖ Allowing another student to drive a vehicle with a hang tag
 - ❖ Excessive parking violations

If an emergency occurs that requires you to drive another vehicle to school, please report the vehicle change to Mrs. Cinelli immediately upon your arrival to school.
